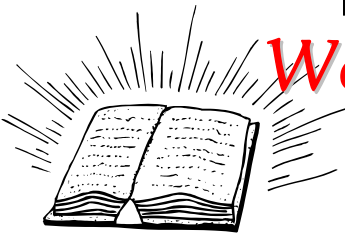

**Grace**

## STEPS TO FORGIVENESS AND SALVATION
