STEPS TO FORGIVENESS AND SALVATION

1. **CONFESS...your sins.** Recognize that all are sinners. Everyone has disobeyed God and is in need of a Savior. (*Romans 3:23 and Romans 6:23*)
2. **BELIEVE...on the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Savior.** Acknowledge that God in love sent Jesus to be your Savior. That Jesus died on the cross to save you from your sins. (*John 3:16 and Acts 16:31*).
3. **ACCEPT...Jesus Christ into your heart and life by faith.** Recognize that we need to personally receive Jesus into our lives as our Savior by prayerfully asking Him in. Follow the suggested prayer below. (*John 1:12 and Acts 2:21*).

Lord Jesus, I confess that I am a sinner. I believe you came and died for **my** sins. I ask you this moment to forgive me and to come into my heart and my life. I will seek to live for you from this day on. In Jesus name, Amen. (Keep this in your Bible).
