

Application Process

The application process is designed to discern God's calling, assess spiritual and doctrinal qualifications, and evaluate readiness for pastoral ministry training. It is straightforward, thorough, and intentional.

1. Application Submission

- Interested candidates submit a comprehensive application that includes:
 - Personal information and contact details
 - Spiritual autobiography: testimony of conversion, faith journey, and sense of calling to pastoral ministry
 - Ministry philosophy statement: understanding of pastoral responsibility, leadership, and shepherding God's people
 - Doctrinal alignment: acknowledgment of agreement with Nute Ridge Bible Chapel's Articles of Faith

2. References

- Applicants must provide at least three references from individuals familiar with their spiritual character and ministry potential.

Program Overview

The Assistant Pastor Program exists to identify and develop men who are called by God to pastoral ministry. This program combines structured ministry experience with theological and practical training under the mentorship of the pastoral team.

Participants will devote 10 hours per week toward ministry and mentoring and will receive \$1,000 per month.

Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- A man called by God to pastoral ministry.
 - A member in good standing of a local church.
 - Agreement with Nute Ridge Bible Chapel's Articles of Faith.
 - Demonstrated evidence of spiritual maturity, teachability, and servant-heartedness.
 - Actively pursuing training or education for ministry (formal or informal).
 - Willingness to commit to 10 hours weekly for ministry involvement, mentoring, and training.
 - Meets qualifications for a pastor as laid out in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1.
